

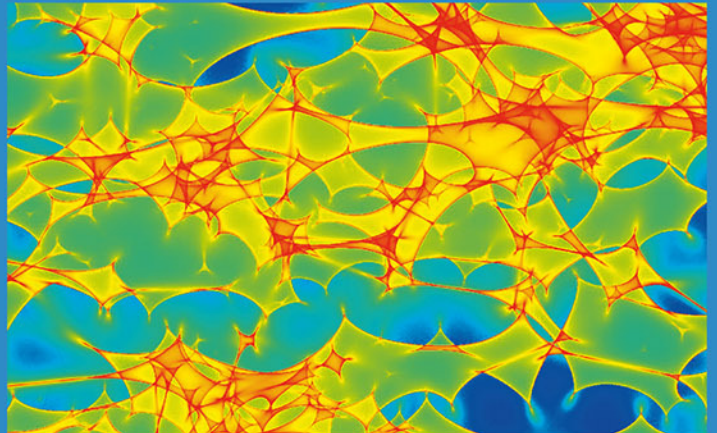

When?

The Master Course starts in September 2011.
The application deadline is:
November 30th 2010 for both European and non-European students.



Where?

I Semester: University of Innsbruck;
II Semester: University of Padova or Rome Tor Vergata;
III Semester: Universities Tor Vergata, Goettingen, or Belgrade;
IV Semester: Master Thesis any of the 5 Universities at choice, with possible co-supervision by different partner institutes.
